UNBRIDELS KING rated off the pace, rallied three wide on the far turn, moved to gain the lead in early stretch and was fully extended to prevail. COAHOMA allowed to settle after breaking slowly, swung to the outside for the stretch run and closed well for the place. CLASSIC PAR off slowly, was unhurried while saving ground, made a run along the inside to loom a threat in midstretch, then weakened. MARCO'S WORD chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. MISTER BLISTER reserved early, angled out and rallied to reach contention in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. BELIEVE I CAN FLY outrun early, advanced into the stretch to loom a factor, then flattened out. HEAR NO EVIL sprinted to a clear lead along the hedge, made the pace into the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth. SMOOTH LOVER showed early foot, stopped and was eased in the stretch run.
