STORM FORCAST forced the pace down the backstretch, eased off the leader while off the rail around the far turn then took over straightening for home and held THEONEILOVE sway while under pressure. THEONEILOVE rated off the pace, raced along the inside on the far turn, then angled out for the drive and rallied to be second best but couldn't match strides with the winner. RAPID FLOW trailed early, raced three wide around the far turn, circled the field and closed to gain the show. RUTHLESS REBECCA set the pace under pressure from the winner down the backstretch, edged away off the rail around the far turn and into the stretch, then gave way. BOOK THE BULLET tracked the speed three wide around the far turn and weakened. MYSTERIOUS LIGHT tired from good position four wide. SUMMER'S LULLABY was outrun.
