HUGO LIGHT chased the pace off the rail, eased inside ROAD TO BABYLON at the top of the stretch, rallied to reach even terms for command approaching the sixteenth pole, then dueled to the wire and prevailed. OLYMPIC TOUR rated off the pace, eased outside the leaders for the stretch run, rallied to catch those rivals nearing the sixteenth pole, then dueled to the wire and just missed. ROAD TO BABYLON set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run, then responded when challenged from both sides approaching the sixteenth pole and continued on gamely between horses while just being edged to the wire. INDIO ROOSTER reserved racing along the rail, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't gain late. JACKWAGON steadied in the early going, stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch and weakened. COMMANDER TATE failed to menace. UNO AGAIN allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and was not a factor. BESSELINK stalked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. RIO GREY was outrun. EURO TIGER trailed.
