SCHATT THE BANDIT showed speed along the inside, repulsed a bid from BROTHERS OUTLAW on the turn, made the pace into the stretch, then was all out to just last over that same rival. BROTHERS OUTLAW chased the pace off the rail, made a run at the winner on the turn, was outmoved by that rival, then came on again under pressure to just miss. I CAN AND I WILL rated off the pace after being pinched back soon after the start, raced three wide around the turn and was no threat to the top ones while holding off CONQUEROR JAK for the show. The latter, unhurried early, failed to menace while closing to just miss the show. EIGHT RIDERS tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and tired. VANISHING BUCK stalked the pace off the rail to midway of the turn, then faltered. YOU ES OH CLUB was outrun.
