SIR OSCAR vied for the lead between horses, then continued to duel with CHARMING JIM to the wire and prevailed. CHARMING JIM vied for the lead along the rail and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. MY FRIEND BRUCE reserved off the pace after bumping with WIND GLIDER and being steadied in the early going, closed to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. TWICE AS BAD off slowly, raced three wide on the turn, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. WESTERN MAN failed to menace. WIND GLIDER bumped and steadied in the early going, was never a factor. PAINTER'S SWORD raced three wide on the turn and tired. ALYAZULI vied for the lead three wide around the turn and faltered. SEA CLIP showed little. MOMENT OF SONG chased the leaders along the inside into the stretch and faded.
