MO'S PRIZE vied for the lead along the rail to deep stretch, then edged away. MY SALLY vied outside MO'S PRIZE to deep stretch, then couldn't stay with that rival while best of the others. COUNT ME OUT chased the leaders into the stretch and gave way. COOPER SAYS chased the pace along the rail, was caught in tight soon after entering the turn, then tired in the drive. LEMON DROP GIRL reserved racing along the rail, steadied leaving the turn and never threatened. GO CHELY GO raced in contention three wide around the turn and faltered. LOVE LOLA was outrun. INDIAN SUMMER GIRL was not a factor. BANNER ELK trailed after breaking slowly and was pulled up leaving the turn.
