TUSCANY LIGHT set the pace along the inside, then drew off when set down for the drive. RAISE THE LEVEL steadied in the early going, angled three wide on the far turn and closed outside the drifting INFINITELY GREEDY to be up for the place while no match for the winner. CATNABOUT unhurried early, advanced off the rail to reach contention in the stretch but couldn't gain late while being edged for the place. INFINITELY GREEDY chased the pace along the rail, made a run at the winner racing into the far turn, then drifted out through the stretch while tiring and was vanned off after the finish. ICANSEECLEARLY up close early, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered. WILD MARTHA chased the leaders into the far turn and gave way. SILVERY PET outrun while saving ground, came out to bump SHESOMETHINGSPECIAL soundly in the stretch and was never a threat. SHESOMETHINGSPECIAL rank in the early going, was no factor when bumped and steadied in the stretch. MISS PTARMIGAN chased the pace into the far turn and faded.
