BAHAMIAN SQUALL chased the pace three wide, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. TRINNIBERG chased the pace off the rail, made a run to reach even terms for command just inside the eighth pole but couldn't stay with the winner while saving the place. JACKSON BEND reserved early, angled out for room in the stretch and closed well to just miss the place. JUSTIN PHILLIP stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly while being edged for the show. TRICKMEISTER stalked the pace along the rail, eased out for the stretch run and didn't do enough late. CLOSE IT OUT unhurried after breaking slowly, steadied outside APRIORITY on the backstretch, then closed ground late along the inside without threatening. BLACK DIAMOND CAT raced four wide and failed to menace. FORT LOUDON rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and never threatened. ARTEFACTO pressed the pace outside CAJUN BREEZE, gained a slim lead from that rival nearing the quarter pole, made the pace to past the eighth pole, then tired. APRIORITY off slowly, steadied to avoid the broken down horse on the backstretch and was not a factor. CAJUN BREEZE set the pace under pressure along the rail to nearing the guarter pole, then faltered. OFF THE JAK broke down in the early going and was pulled up.
