ANGEL OF HOPE showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew off when asked. RHAPSODY OF DREAMS unhurried early, closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. FLOR DE CANELA rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and couldn't keep pace with the winner while just being edged for the place. BEAUTIFUL INSIGHT chased the winner into the stretch, then had nothing left. PURA raced three wide and tired. MAXIMUM GLIDE off slowly, was outrun. NANDANI steadied from tight quarters soon after the start, saved ground and faltered. TOP MAMA broke poorly, moved up to chase the pace around the turn, then faded. JUST APRIL was through early.
