FAMOUS PATRIOT chased the pace, rallied to gain command at the top of the stretch, then drew clear. BE WELCOME set the pace off the rail, angled to the inside on the far turn while continuing to make the pace to the top of the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while saving the place. STIMULUS PLAN outrun early, advanced four wide around the far turn but couldn't gain on the winner late while just missing the place. CALPULLEC rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. GONE STRAIGHT stalked the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. QUIET EMARATI was never a factor. MATAI stumbled at the start and was through after a half mile.
