**Footnotes**

PEB HUGHES showed speed along the inside, drew away around the turn and into the stretch, then remained well clear to the wire under urging. TERRIFFIC LIGHT rated off the pace after being bumped and steadied from between rivals at the start, swung out for the stretch run, then closed to gain the place. CODE TAKER rated in striking position off the pace, had no late response. SLAM FIRE chased the winner off the rail into the stretch and tired. CELLARS CABERNET outrun after being steadied when he bumped soundly with TERRIFFIC LIGHT in the early going, failed to menace. TRUMP CARD was not a factor. WAIKIKI tracked the leaders three wide into the turn and faltered. BALTIMORE SAINT showed little after bumping hard with TERRIFFIC LIGHT in the early going.
