NINEINTHENINE stalked the pace, angled outside the leaders for the stretch run, rallied to catch BINGO BANGO BONGO at the sixteenth pole and edged away. BINGO BANGO BONGO prompted the pace outside UFFIZI, gained a slim lead from that rival leaving the far turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole was outfinished. LIBERTY CAP off slowly, stalked the pace three wide, made a run at the lead in the stretch, then weakened. MY POCKET ACE steadied along in behind the leader in the early going, tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch, then gave way. UFFIZI set the pace along the inside to nearing the top of the stretch, then tired. SWEEPING VICTORY rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. SURELY SENT was not a factor.
