### Footnotes

URBANA LIGHT set the pace off the rail, increased her margin in midstretch and was under pressure to remain clear to the wire. YOUR SONG advanced three wide to reach the attending position racing down the backstretch, then chased the winner into the stretch and couldn't get to that rival while clearly second best. WORTHY YOU chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. REIMA ROSE rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered. BETAIRAI was through early. PYRITE JET trailed.
