SILVER CHARITY set the pace along the inside, then drew off when set down for the drive. KISS FOR KRIS rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. RUBY DELIGHT unhurried early, passed tired rivals for the show. UNFAIR chased the winner into the stretch and tired. MABEL SYRUP chased the leaders into the far turn and faltered. EPONINA was not a factor. TRAVIATA reserved off the pace, faded leaving the far turn. DAVID'S DELIGHT was done early and eased in the final eighth. GET DAT MONEY HUNY was outrun and eased in the stretch run. WAKE ME NOW showed brief speed, stopped abruptly racing into the far turn and was eased.
