Footnotes

TRIPSKI reserved early, raced three wide around the turn, then rallied to be just up at the wire. ASSORTED COLORS chased the pace along the rail, was blocked in behind NIGHT OF POWER from the top of the stretch to the eighth pole, got through inside that rival and opened a clear inside the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. GENERATION SPEED pressed the pace outside NIGHT OF POWER to past the eighth pole, then weakened. DON TITO allowed to settle after breaking a step slowly, found his best stride late. NIGHT OF POWER showed speed along the inside to past the eighth pole, then gave way. SLAM FIRE tracked the pace into the stretch but had no response when asked. ARMED DEPLOYMENT was not a factor. MR. HERMAN well place early, faltered.
