### Footnotes

WOKE UP DREAMIN chased the pace, angled outside DON SIX leaving the backstretch, rallied three wide to take over leaving the turn, then drew clear under pressure. TOSCANI vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. NIGHTMARE AFFAIR unhurried after bumping with HITTHEGROUNDUNNIN and being steadied at the start, closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. MISTER FOTIS steadied when he bumped with HITTHEGROUNDUNNIN at the start, saved ground around the turn and lacked a late response. DON SIX vied for the lead from the outside, continued to contest the pace outside TOSCANI around the turn when GREGSON dropped back, then tired in the drive. PARADISE DANCER was no factor while racing three wide. ABBONDANZA broke to the inside contributing to crowding, tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch, then faltered. HITTHEGROUNDUNNIN was outrun after being bumped and steadied from between rivals at the start. GREGSON showed speed between rivals to the turn and faded.
