Footnotes

RACHEL'S DANCER rated off the pace after stumbling at the start, angled outside the leaders in the stretch and rallied to be up late. JAKES R WILD chased the pace, moved to take over in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner late while holding the place. EASTERN SEABOARD showed speed along the inside, dropped back when steadied leaving the first turn, stalked the pace along the rail, was steadied again in behind rivals on the far turn and didn't do enough late. UNTUTTABLE AFFAIR showed speed outside EASTERN SEABOARD, edged clear while moving to the rail racing down the backstretch, responded when challenged by JAKES R WILD on the far turn, then gave way in the final eighth. CHAZMULE unhurried early, advanced into contention around the far turn but had no further response. LIMONADA was caught in tight early, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then was caught in tight again inside the eighth pole and tired. HURRICANE HEAT reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and faltered.
