TAXES TAXES TAXES raced with the pace four wide, then dueled with CELLARS CABERNET through the stretch and edged away late. CELLARS CABERNET raced with the pace along the rail, then dueled with TAXES TAXES TAXES through the stretch and weakened late. RARE RANSOM reserved early, advanced into contention around the far turn, angled out for the drive and gave way. CIRCLING THE BASES set the pace three wide into the far turn, continued to contest the pace between rivals into the stretch, then tired. FABULOUS TEXAS raced with the pace between horses into the far turn, then faltered. PETEY BEDOUIN broke poorly, then was no factor while racing four wide. BROMANCE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faded. DREAMING FREE (VEN) stumbled at the start, saved ground and dropped back through the stretch run.
