Footnotes

MIDNIGHT SERENADE rated off the pace, came in inside the sixteenth pole impeding SENOR CASTRICO while rallying to be up in time. BURNING TIME unhurried after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the turn, angled to the outside in the stretch and closed well to be up for the place. BIG DREAMS vied for the lead along the rail, drew clear in midstretch, then gave way late. TURBO CANNON chased the pace three wide, then bumped with TRITONK at the sixteenth pole and was gaining at the finish. TRITONK reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, raced four wide around the turn, then bumped with TURBO CANNON at the sixteenth pole and didn't do enough late. SENOR CASTRICO tracked the pace, advanced off the rail to reach the attending position in the stretch, then checked when impeded by MIDNIGHT SERENADE inside the sixteenth pole and failed to recover. PUT IT BACK TIGER saved ground and failed to menace. LORDSHIP'S FLEET was no factor after breaking poorly. JULIOS CAT vied for the lead outside BIG DREAMS, then tired in the drive. FARMERS MARKET off slowly, trailed. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of SENOR CASTRICO, MIDNIGHT SERENADE was disqualified and placed sixth for interference to that rival inside the sixteenth pole.
