ITAWTISAWAPUTTYTAT showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then drew away when set down for the drive. HORAH FOR BAILEY off slowly, chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then was no match for the winner in the drive while clearly second best. ATLANTIC SNOW unhurried early, passed tired rivals to gain the show. JO JO chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. RUN N LOVE chased the early pace and faltered. FORTUNATE ANGEL was no factor after breaking poorly. CALLSPORTS was outrun after breaking slowly. HAWAIIAN THUNDER trailed after ducking in and being checked at the start.
