LITTLE NICK reserved racing along the hedge, angled out in the stretch, then rallied to be up in the final strides. MR. NIGHTLINGER vied for the lead racing just off the hedge, edged away from SIR EDGAR in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. DUKES FLYING TIGER unhurried after being steadied when he bumped with SUPREMACY at the start, rallied for the show. POSSETOTHEMAX tracked the pace four wide around the turn and had no late response. MIDNIGHT RIDGE chased the pace along the hedge, was steadied from close quarters entering the turn, remained in contention along the hedge into the stretch, then gave way. LORD ROBYN chased the pace three wide to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. RON BOB AND DAVE off slowly, failed to menace. SUPREMACY was no factor after bumping with DUKES FLYING TIGER at the start. HONEY HONEY HONEY was outrun. SIR EDGAR vied for the lead outside MR. NIGHTLINGER to nearing the stretch, then faltered.
