Footnotes

ATLANTIC HURRICANE reserved racing along the inside, eased out in the stretch, rallied to catch CUMANA just inside the eighth pole, then was all out to prevail. CUMANA rated off the pace, rallied to gain the lead leaving the far turn, maintained a slim advantage to inside the eighth pole, then gave way grudgingly. RUN JAMAICAN'S RUN tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn, then had no response while edging DREAM WITH US for the show. The latter, set the pace along the rail, responded when headed by CUMANA, stayed with that rival to the eighth pole, then tired. LADY LOUSHE allowed to settle after being caught in tight at the start, made a run around the far turn to loom a threat, then faltered in the drive. SKY CAP was no factor while racing four wide. CUGATCHA prompted the pace outside DREAM WITH US into the backstretch, then faded.
