BENNY THE BULL unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead just inside the eighth pole, then edged away. HOW'S YOUR HALO reserved off the pace while saving ground, came around MAN OF DANGER on the turn, rallied along the inside to reach even terms for command at the eighth pole and continued on with good courage for the place while being outfinished by the winner. ROCKERFELLER stalked the pace four wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole, then weakened. RAVALO vied for the lead three wide around the turn and tired. BLUE PEPSI LODGE vied for the lead between horses, continued to contest the pace to the eighth pole, then faltered. INDIAN CHANT broke awkwardly, then was no threat while racing four wide. FINALLYMADEIT was outrun. WINNIES TIGGER TOO stalked the leaders three wide around the turn and faded. MAN OF DANGER vied for the lead along the rail into the turn, then had nothing left.
