### Footnotes

SHATTERED GLASS chased the pace, rallied to catch ALKE BELLE at the eighth pole, then drew off under urging. READY TO REPENT chased the pace three wide into the stretch but was no match for the winner while gaining the place. TEQUILA RIDGE reserved after breaking slowly, raced four wide around the turn and closed to be up for the show. DONAMIA outrun early, improved her position without threatening. ALKE BELLE sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then tired. SOAP QUEEN failed to menace after bumping with FUZZY GUT GIRL at the start. FUZZY GUT GIRL bumped with SOAP QUEEN at the start, saved ground and never threatened. WAX POETIC raced three wide and was not a factor. T. S. FAY well placed early, faded.
