TRICK THE QUEEN reserved along the inside, eased three wide on the far turn, rallied to catch FLATTER ME LUCKY entering the stretch, then drew off while being kept to pressure. FLATTER ME LUCKY rated off the pace, rallied to take over racing down the backstretch, made the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then was no match for the winner while just saving the place. PLEASANT MCGEE unhurried early, steadied along the inside on the far turn, angled three wide for room, then closed to just miss the place while never a threat to the winner. MARIE'S MUSIC rated off the pace, tired in the drive. BODY HEAT tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered. BABY ALEXANDRA steadied soon after the start, raced four wide and faded. DUCHESS DENYSE chased the pace off the rail to the far turn, then stopped and was eased in the final eighth. MINIVAN set the pace along the inside to nearing the half mile marker, then had nothing left and was eased in the stretch run.
