COOPER'S PICK bobbled at the start, showed speed racing off the rail, increased her margin in midstretch after her rider lost his whip at the top of the stretch, then was under a strong hand ride to prevail. SQUAW'S PROSPECT chased the pace into the stretch and gained some ground on the winner while clearly second best. RICH AND SAFE showed speed along the inside and tired. WAGERING ANGEL checked from tight quarters leaving the chute and failed to menace. REALLY STRIKING was through early. CARELESS GOLD was outrun. SALITROSA was never close. CRIMSON KISS showed little. INNOCENT REMARK off slowly, was hustled to reach contention three wide, then faltered.
