FLY ME ALI chased the pace, rallied to take over entering the stretch, then drew away under urging. LAURAE LISES SISTER outrun early, saved ground into the stretch and closed with belated rally between horses to be up for the place. FORMAL FANNY bobbled at the start, showed speed along the rail into the stretch and weakened. TRIPLE SLAM unhurried early, improved her position without threatening. SAMI'S GIRL failed to menace. CHAMPAIGN POWDER showed early foot along the inside and gave way. MANGO LASSIE rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. ACTALITTLE raced in striking position to midway of the turn and faltered.
