NOTHIN' BUT SASS reserved early, saved ground and passed tired rivals for the show. A CURIOUS LADY broke a step slowly, showed early foot and tired. SOPHIA'S PRINCESS showed speed along the rail into the turn, then faltered. RUN ELLIE RUN was not a factor. MONT STELLA was done early.
