DELIGHTFUL DAWN reserved off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn to catch TAKE ME TO ZUBER at the top of the stretch, then drew away from that rival through the final eighth. TAKE ME TO ZUBER stalked the pace, rallied to gain a brief lead at the quarter pole, responded when headed by DELIGHTFUL DAWN at the top of the stretch but was no match for that rival in the final eighth. HOT CAPPUCINO unhurried while saving ground, swung wide for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. MY OTHER GIRL stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. STATION HILL stalked the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. SHE IS ARE LADY bumped hard with A SAINT AMONG US at the start, set the pace along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then faded. BLUE ANGEL EXPRESS was through after six furlongs. A SAINT AMONG US was outrun after bumping hard with SHE IS ARE LADY at the start.
