### Footnotes

TIZNOW MYTIME chased the pace, eased outside the leaders on the turn, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole, then drew clear under urging. STAMEN pressed the pace outside LANDS N TRADITIONS, took over from that rival on the turn, made the pace into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the rest. TOUR DE COMPRISE well placed early, couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. BLAST OF MACHO tracked the pace three wide around the turn and tired. BEST TRIP was tracking the pace along the rail, when checked to avoid running up on LANDS N TRADITIONS on the turn, checked again when unable to get through inside that rival entering the stretch, then checked a final time in behind that one in the stretch and failed to recover. OMEGA RISING off slowly, raced four wide and faltered. LANDS N TRADITIONS set the pace along the inside into the turn, then couldn't stay with STAMEN and faded.
