Footnotes

FLAMBE' allowed to settle, rallied under pressure to catch HIDDEN CREEK at the sixteenth pole and win going away. HIDDEN CREEK off slowly, rushed to a clear lead while in hand but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final sixteenth while just saving the place. REGAL COUNTESS chased the pace three wide into the stretch and closed to just miss the place. JEANETTE'S ROLLS raced four wide on the turn and lacked a rally. ELO'S CREEK was never a factor. THE WILDEST THING chased the pace along the inside and tired. SNOGUN steadied from between rivals entering the turn and was outrun. MOMSCOMANDWEWILSEE showed little. REALIZATION was never close after breaking slowly.
