Footnotes

SARA'S SUCCESS tracked pace the pace after bobbling at the start, was checked when caught in tight leaving the far turn, recovered and rallied inside MAN I LOVE CLARE to be just up. The latter, unhurried early, circled rivals four wide on the far turn to take over at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead, then drifted out late and just failed to last. FROZEN DINNER reserved racing along the rail, was attempting to make a run along the rail when forced to steady inside ALL PLUM GOLD entering the far turn, waited for room in behind that rival into the stretch, angled out and gained the show. ALL PLUM GOLD rated off the pace, made a run along the inside to reach even terms for command midway of the far turn, then tired. REGAL COUNTESS showed speed three wide outside MULTIPLICITY into the backstretch, chased the pace into the far turn and faltered. HOLINESS hesitated at the start and was never close. MULTIPLICITY showed speed off the rail into the far turn, then faded when she bled and was eased in the final eighth.
