IMAWILDANDCRAZYGUY rated off the pace, was caught in traffic on the turn, eased out for room in the stretch and rallied to be up late. FORTY ZIP tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and closed to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. ROOSEVELT reserved early, raced four wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. WORLD WAR bumped with FORTUNATELY BOLD at the start, showed speed along the inside, increased his advantage in midstretch, then gave way late. BRICKLAND chased the pace to inside the eighth pole and tired. FORTUNATELY BOLD unhurried after being bounced around at the start, improved his position in the drive. IRISH BRIAN well placed after bumping with FORTUNATELY BOLD at the start, saved ground around the turn and faltered. BOODER'S BROTHER was no factor while racing three wide. I AIN'T NO SAINT showed brief speed and faded. JUDE'S STAR trailed after breaking poorly and was eased in the stretch run.
