OLIGARCH set the pace along the inside into the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. UNO AGAIN stalked the pace along the rail, moved into the attending position entering the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner late. STORM CHART unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly for the show. THE BEST GLACIER prompted the pace outside OLIGARCH to nearing the stretch, then gave way. CAT 'N FIDDLE allowed to settle, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out and didn't do enough late. SASTRE stalked the leaders into the stretch and tired. GROVE HALL raced three wide and failed to menace. EL UNO stalked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faltered.
