BERNARDINE'S GIFT reserved off the pace after breaking a step slowly, rallied along the rail to take over at the eighth pole, then drew clear. SASSY Q rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn, rallied to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole but couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage to prove best of the rest. FOREVER CANDY chased the pace off the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole, then tired. CASH BELONGINGS was not a factor after she dwelt at the start. SYDNEY RULES chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered. HOT STEPPING LASS sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run and faded.
