SPARKLING GLITTER sprinted clear while saving ground around the turn and was kept to pressure. GERRY'S BACKDRAFT split horses to make a run nearing the stretch and continued on with good energy.CANNON WHIRL angled out eight wide while moving into the stretch and finished with good energy. DANI MAX prompted the pace into the stretch and weakened. CAROL'S TURN well placed to the stretch lacked a rally. INSPIRATION MISS a factor to the final furlong, weakened and finished on even terms with NO PROSPECT. NO PROSPECT made up some ground late while finishing between horses. MUSICAL YASNA angled out 9 wide for the drive and was gaining late. REGAL ALIX steadied after the start, failed to threaten. UCANTSTOPTHEMUSIC raced seven wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SHANESHANE was never close.
