**Footnotes**

NEW JERSEY PHIL showed speed off the rail, drew clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to last over SAVANNAH'S SON. The latter, tracked the pace, angled to the outside for the drive and was gaining on the winner at the finish. SQUIRT MONSTER well placed while saving ground, couldn't keep pace with the top ones in the drive while up for the show. MOMENT OF SONG failed to menace after breaking slowly and being steadied at the start. THATS DANNYS BUCK chased the pace four wide to inside the eighth pole and tired. MEADOW FUN forced the pace along the inside to midway of the turn and faltered. FASTER PROSPECT raced in striking position three wide around the turn and faded.
