**Footnotes**

THE REAL FUTURE reserved off the pace, steadied to avoid running up on MISS CHAIRMAN soon after entering the far turn, raced three wide into the stretch, then rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away. AMERICAN BORDER allowed to settle, saved ground around the far turn, was outmoved by the winner when forced to alter course outside a wall of horses in the stretch, then rallied to be up for the place. CHRISSEY'S HONOR chased the pace along the inside, eased out and made a run to reach even terms for command inside the eighth pole but was outfinished. HIGH ALTITUDE sprinted to a clear lead while angling over to the rail, made the pace to inside the eighth pole and gave way. CARA BONITA outrun early, passed tired rivals. LADY ELIZABETH unhurried early, rallied to reach the leader on the far turn, then tired. MISS CHAIRMAN raced in striking position into the far turn, then faltered. MARCHESA's rider lost his left iron at the start, recovered and moved up to track the pace into the far turn, then faded. REXSON'S TOUR was done early.
