Footnotes

REFLECTED CAT stalked the pace three wide, moved up to engage the leaders entering the far turn, gained a slim lead at the eighth pole, then was all out to just last over VENGAMI NINO. The latter, unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn, angled in and rallied inside REFLECTED CAT to just miss. SAINT NICHOLAS tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly along the outside while being edged to the wire by the top ones. BROADWAY ACTOR set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged on the far turn, stayed with the REFLECTED CAT to inside the sixteenth pole and weakened. LET IT ROCK reserved off the pace, failed to threaten while closing with a mild response. DECAF AGAIN rated off the pace, saved ground and couldn't gain late. ALKAZABITO stalked the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command between horses racing into the far turn, then tired. ALEJANDRO was outrun.
