LAKE NONA reserved racing along the inside, was blocked in behind the leaders entering the stretch, slipped through inside CAPTAIN HENRY and rallied to gain the lead just past the eighth pole, then edged away. GO ZAPPER stalked the pace, eased out and made a run to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole but couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. SASSARION allowed to settle after hesitating at the start, swung out for the stretch run and closed to gain the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. AS DE COPAS vied for the lead outside CAPTAIN HENRY, gained a slim lead in early stretch, then gave way in the final eighth. SANSKRIT rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch, then flattened out. HOLD THAT CAMERA outrun after he reared at the start, gained some ground without threatening. MR. IZZY failed to menace. THREEHIFIVES was no factor while racing four wide. CAPTAIN HENRY vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch, then tired. AZUL COAST showed brief speed, chased the pace along the rail to the far turn, then faded.
