SECRET REQUEST reserved while saving ground, checked inside DAKOTA LIGHT approaching the quarter pole, altered course to the outside in midstretch and rallied to be just up at the wire. CHASE GAP unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to gain a slim lead in deep stretch but was edged to the wire in the final strides. DAKOTA LIGHT rated off the pace, angled inside ROMANESQUE for room approaching the quarter pole, eased back out and rallied to gain a slim lead at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished in the final seventy yards. PAMPERED PRINCESS outran ROMANESQUE for the lead, set the pace under pressure along the rail to inside the eighth pole and weakened. SILVER LACE chased the pace three wide to inside the eighth pole and tired. ROMANESQUE pressed the pace outside PAMPERED PRINCESS into the far turn and faltered. GENTILLE ALOUETTE trailed.
