QUEEN DRAMA tracked the pace, rallied four wide to take over at the top of the stretch, then was fully extended to hold off SINNER'S GOLD. The latter, tracked the pace along the inside, came around CONWAY TWO STEP and made a run along the rail to reach the winner at the eighth pole but couldn't gain on that rival late. ANGEL DREAMS showed brief speed, eased back and angled three wide on the turn, made a run to join the leaders racing into the stretch, then weakened in the final eighth. CHAR LENA JO vied for the lead outside CONWAY TWO STEP to the top of the stretch, then gave way. FRENCH POLITICS rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and tired. GLADY N GLORY reserved off the pace, faltered in the drive. LIVING LIGHT was not a factor. CONWAY TWO STEP vied for the lead, moved to the inside on the turn while continuing to contest the pace with CHAR LENA JO to nearing the eighth pole, then faded. ELSIE'S PRINCESS off slowly, saved ground and trailed.
