**Footnotes**

IMPERIAL ROBYN chased the pace four wide, then closed to be up late while drifting in. BEA TOP QUALITY rated off the pace, steadied in traffic soon after entering the turn, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner late. CIRCLE VALLEY chased the pace off the rail, moved to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, then weakened in the final eighth. YA YA'S RULES reserved racing five wide, angled in while advancing into the stretch but had no late response. DIRECTION TO PAY chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. GLOBAL RONNIE off slowly, failed to menace. CHICKS DIG ME was no threat while racing four wide. STARSHIP CAPTAIN allowed to settle after breaking a step slowly, tired in the drive. DYNAMIC DUKE showed speed along the inside to the top of the stretch, then faltered. CEDAR KEY SUNSET was outrun. MAX'S HERO was never close after breaking poorly. SMOOTH AND COOL saved ground and faded.
