Footnotes

FEASTORFAMINE chased the pace three wide, moved to take over on the turn, repulsed a bid from QUREALL and edged away through the final sixteenth. QUREALL bobbed at the start, was tracking the pace when steadied in behind the leaders on the turn, angled out and made a run four wide to join FEASTORFAMINE racing into the stretch, tried that rival to the sixteenth pole, then weakened. DEPUTY DANCE vied for the lead outside KING MONGO to past midway of the turn, then gave way. FLINT MOUNTAIN chased the leaders four wide around the turn and tired. KING MONGO broke a step slowly, moved up to vie for the lead along the rail to past midway of the turn, then faltered. FREEDOM ISNT FREE off a step slowly, was never a factor. CUCINA NICK saved ground and faded. FIVE CARD MONTY raced four wide and was done early.
