ENOUGH THUNDER made the lead two wide on the first turn, set the balance of the pace while getting slow fractions and prevailed under strong handling. PARIS WEEKEND unhurried while along the inside, moved up on the second turn, bid into the stretch and finished second best. COOL CAROLINA trailed along the inside, checked while advancing entering the second turn then came on again through the stretch along the rail. FIRST MANDATE set the pace into the first turn while along the rail for six furlongs, drifted out through the stretch and failed to offer a closing response. ISSUES ECHO was a sharp threat three wide into the stretch then weakened. PORT AU PRINCESS had speed for six furlongs while hung four wide then flattened out.
