ANSWER THE STORM vied for the lead outside DADS DESTROYER, opened a clear lead in midstretch, then was under a strong hand ride to hold LAND THE LIMIT safe. The latter, chased the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the turn and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. ENDLESS PLEASURE reserved after being bumped by KEEP IT COMIN at the start, raced three wide on the turn and gained the show. CONCERTA raced three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and lacked a rally. DADS DESTROYER vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch and tired. KEEP IT COMIN hit the gate and bumped ENDLESS PLEASURE at the start, then was outrun while racing along the rail. DIXIE TRIXIE was through early.
