JAMES WILFRED unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to be up in the final strides. UNIQUE AFLEET rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to gain the lead approaching the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. JOHANNESBURG PLACE allowed to settle, raced four wide around the far turn and finished willingly to just miss the place. STRAIGHT MONEY MAN sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, made the pace to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. CHINSEGUT BAY stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then tired. VALUE DRIVER failed to menace. B L'S WHO'S WHO chased the pace to nearing the far turn, then faltered. SERAPI CAT was outrun.
