IVANAVINALOT reserved after breaking slowly, was advancing along the inside when forced to steady to avoid running up on the heels of SUNNY VICTORY, steadied again when that rival came out off the rail in midstretch, angled to the inside and rallied to be up late. SUNNY VICTORY set the pace under pressure along the inside, edged away in midstretch while coming out of the rail but couldn't hold off the winner late. MEAMA unhurried after breaking slowly, advanced along the rail to reach contention in the stretch but couldn't gain late. FOREST NATIVE pressed the pace three wide around the turn and weakened. PASTA FAZOOOL was no factor after breaking slowly. EXPECTANT pressed the pace outside SUNNY VICTORY into the stretch, then tired. ELECTRICAL CARLITA showed early foot, raced three wide on the turn and faltered.
