REALLY STRIKING set the pace along the inside, shook off a challenge from QUICK CORSAGE on the turn, then drew away through the stretch under urging. I'M A WILD ANGEL reserved early, advanced four wide around the turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. TWINING GLOW taken in behind the leaders, raced off the rail and gained the show while no threat to the top ones. AMBER RUN raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. QUICK CORSAGE chased the pace, made a run at the winner soon after entering the turn, then tired in the drive. TOUR'S QUICK GAL stalked the pace three wide to midway of the turn and faltered. SWEEPING EIGHT saved ground and faded. SIBERGACE was checked when she broke out at the start and trailed.
