GASTON A. disputed the pace from the outset, inherited a comfortable advantage when Carolina Mist took back into the far turn then was all out to last. ASGOODASSHELOOKS reserved off the early leaders, steadied briefly along the inside into the far turn, saved ground and finished with good energy to just miss. FREEDOM AFLEET raced well placed and rallied mildly. MALITZIN dropped far back early then made up ground down the center of the track without threatening. CAROLINA MIST contested the pace inside Gaston A., steadied back suddenly into the far turn, remained in contention but lacked a final bid. ROCKIN INTHE RAIN raced wide and was no factor. THERESE bled. ARIEL BRIGHT was angled very wide on the turn and into the stretch. AFRICAN TALKER rushed to close contention down the backstretch but was done early.
